Envelope Fundraiser

Our Fundraising efforts are in full swing. In the last PAC meeting the parents propose "The Envelope Fundraiser" to purchase Ukuleles for the school music program.

How the Envelope Fundraiser Works

- 1. Each student picks an envelope from a box and takes it home.
- 2. Each envelope has a different dollar amount written inside the envelope (\$5, \$10, \$20, \$30). The student is to raise the amount that is written in the envelope they chose. (They can raise more if they want.) (Ask friends, family, neighbours, PVCA staff)
- 3. Once their money is raised, they will bring it to the school office.
- Once all the envelopes are returned, we will order the ukuleles.
- So, don't take too long!!! We want to order the ukuleles as soon as possible!!
